



Chemicals is awarded the EcoVadis platinum medal for the second year in a row

For the second year in a row, Moeve's chemical business — the world's leading producer of LAB and the second largest phenol and acetone manufacturer — has been awarded the platinum medal by EcoVadis, the highest rating granted by this global platform that assesses companies' sustainability performance worldwide. With this recognition, in 2025 Moeve Chemicals keeps its position in the top 1% of companies in terms of sustainability, according to this rating.

The new platinum medal awarded to Moeve demonstrates the chemical business's commitment to responsibly managing all aspects of its activity.

Specifically, this year Chemicals has obtained a global result of 87 points out of 100, which represents an improvement of 7 points compared to last year's score.

By areas, a score of 88/100 was obtained in the environment section, while the company reached 91/100 in the chapter on labor practices and human rights, an increase of 11 points compared to 2024 results.

The highest increase was seen in the Ethics segment score, which at 84/100 was 24 points higher than the previous year. Finally, in the sustainable procurement section the company achieved a score of 77/100. With this result, Moeve Chemicals consolidates its position as one of the most committed chemicals companies worldwide in terms of sustainability.

EcoVadis is a globally recognized international company that rates the sustainability performance of organizations in relation to four ESG areas: environment, labor practices and human rights, ethics, and sustainable procurement. It is the most highly trusted corporate sustainability assessment company globally, having evaluated more than 150,000 companies from all over the world based on sustainability management criteria.
